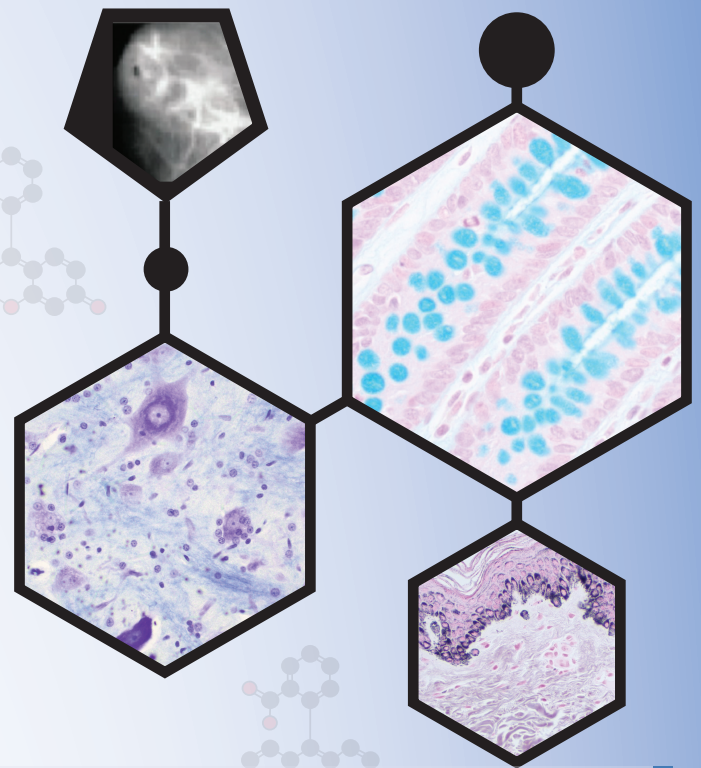
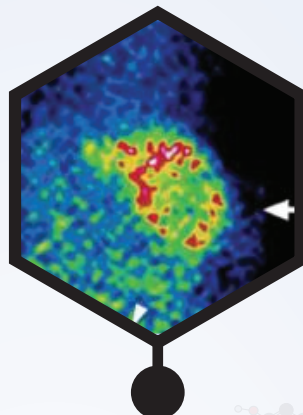


The Biological Stain Commission 44th Annual Conference Methods & Applications in Staining, Biomarkers, and Therapeutics
